

# Eastbourne District Scout First Aid Team

This is the First Aid Treatment Trailer for the Eastbourne District Scout First Aid Team (EDSFAT). The vehicle was purchased in early 2007.



The trailer provides a single York 4 stretcher for treatment as well as a three person cushioned bench at the front.

It is equipped with a large range of First Aid items which allow it to be towed to an event and used immediately. It has more stock than would be expected in a First Aid kit allowing it to be used as a First Aid base for a number of days. The trailer is also equipped with an orthopaedic scoop stretcher.

The trailer was used extensively at the World Scout Jamboree in 2007, both during the event and during the build period whilst the main medical facilities were being built.

Lights and power are provided either by a mains connection (generator or other) or via the inbuilt 12 volt system. There are overhead general lights as well as one spot light on each side allowing for closer inspection of injuries. The trailer is also provided with two communication radios (the Team PMR system and CB), to allow the trailer to be used as a stand alone base at an event, as well as a standard CD player/radio for helping with the quiet times!



A safe and secure drug storage box has been installed in the trailer for standard "Over the Counter" medicines. This allows the medicines to be locked away out of sight after administration.

As well as this vehicle the First Aid Team operates a number of other vehicles:

- Transit Front Line First Aid Unit
- Land Rover First Aid Unit
- First Aid Radio Control Vehicle
- Equipment Trailer
