

Eastbourne District Scout First Aid Team

This is the Front Line First Aid Unit for the Eastbourne District Scout First Aid Team (EDSFAT).

This vehicle contains all the equipment you would find in a normal ambulance for use by both first aid staff and professionally qualified volunteers.

It has full diagnostic capabilities, including: Temperature, Blood Pressure, Pulse Rate, Oxygen Saturations, Peak Flow and Blood Glucose.

As well as this it has Oxygen therapy equipment, Resuscitation equipment and Entonox pain relieving gas, plus all the normal first aid equipment you would expect to find.

For the transportation of patients the ambulance has a Ferno easy lift stretcher, 2 fold-away forward facing seats and a built in child seat. The vehicle also carries a range of ambulance aid equipment for immobilising and transporting the sick or injured, including orthopaedic scoop stretcher and vacuum mattress, as well as the traditional long board.



The vehicle is marked to the current EU standard and has full visual and audible warning equipment.

For effective communication it has both a dedicated mobile phone, with Bluetooth hands free and a PMR radio system so it can be in constant contact with our control vehicle.



This vehicle is used at events with road access, or where the transportation of patients off site is required, where access is difficult the team uses its 4x4 Land Rover ambulance.

As well as this vehicle the First Aid Team operates a number of other vehicles:

- First Aid Treatment Trailer
- First Aid Radio Control Vehicle
- Equipment Trailer
